



## CHÂTEAU DE LACQUY

France's Oldest Family Estate for Armagnac

### Since 1711 - Authentic Heritage

Château de Lacquy is the oldest family estate in France's Gascony region, remaining in the hands of the same family for three centuries. The Bouasson family, now in their 11th generation, maintains the unbroken tradition of French distillation artistry.

### Terroir and Technology

The estate is located in the heart of Bas-Armagnac's "Golden Triangle." The 35 hectares of vineyards grow on iron and sand-rich soils, which impart exceptional complexity to the armagnac.

Distillation is carried out using a traditional wood-fired still from 1939, while the spirits age in 420-liter oak barrels. Three principal grape varieties are used: Baco, Folle Blanche, and Colombard.

## Millésime Collection

### An expression of time and terroir.

Each Millésime (vintage) Armagnac is distilled from a single harvest year and aged in oak barrels for decades, revealing the unique character of that specific vintage. Carefully selected for their balance, complexity, and aging potential, these expressions reflect the soul of Château de Lacquy — authentic, rare, and timeless.

## Assembly Collection

### Crafted consistency and house signature.

The Assembly range blends eaux-de-vie of different ages and grape varieties to create harmonious, signature

profiles. Designed to showcase balance, roundness, and finesse, these Armagnacs offer a consistent and refined tasting experience. Ideal for both connoisseurs and newcomers alike.

## Vintage Collection

### Pure, unblended expressions.

Each Vintage bottling captures the essence of a single year and grape variety, distilled and aged independently. These Armagnacs are bottled without blending, preserving the individuality of their origin. Perfect for collectors and those seeking singular moments in time.



### Historical Legacy and the Art of Wine

In 1731, Michel Bouchard founded a textile business, which in 1746 led Joseph Bouchard to acquire the first vineyards. Today, nearly three centuries and nine generations later, Bouchard Père & Fils remains one of Burgundy's most venerable and respected houses.

Since 1820, the underground cellars of Château de Beaune, a former 15th-century royal fortress, provide optimal conditions for wine aging and development. This historical continuity endows each bottle with incomparable legitimacy and depth.

### Philosophy & Craftsmanship

Bouchard Père & Fils doesn't merely make wine; they breathe life into wine. Cultivation and vinification, plot by plot, represent a form of artisanship passed from generation to generation.

## Grand Cru Collection

This collection features the estate's most prestigious wines from Burgundy's top vineyard classifications. These wines are known for their complexity, minerality, refined structure, and exceptional aging potential.

## FAMILLE HUGEL

Alsace Wine Ambassador Since 1639.

### Family Tradition and the Art of Wine

In 1639, Hans Ulrich Hugel, a Swiss émigré who left his homeland during the Thirty Years' War, established the wine house in Riquewihr. Today, nearly four centuries and 13 generations later, Famille Hugel remains one of the leaders in Alsace wine industry.

Since 1639, Ulrich Hugel led the local winemakers' guild, demonstrating the family's deep connection to the art of winemaking. They are members of Primum Familiae Vini, representing the elite association of the world's leading family wine companies.

### Wine Heritage in the Heart of Alsace

Famille Hugel owns 30 hectares of prime vineyard sites around Riquewihr, where wine culture has existed for more than 2,000 years. The family owns 30 hectares of vineyards, mostly classified as Grand Cru, and additionally purchases grapes from another 110 hectares.




Today, Canard-Duchêne holds a unique place in the world of Champagne — a name synonymous with elegance, depth, and perfectly crafted blends.

### **The Terroir**

Situated in the heart of Montagne de Reims, Canard-Duchêne is surrounded by prestigious vineyards and striking natural beauty. Since 1927, this area has been officially recognized as part of the Champagne Appellation, prized for its challenging climate, chalk-rich subsoil, and undulating hills — all contributing to the complexity and character of the wines.



## IL PALAGIO

Il Palagio represents a harmonious convergence of historic winemaking tradition and contemporary cultural sensibility. This 16th-century estate, nestled in the heart of Tuscany, has preserved its architectural character and agricultural heritage for over five centuries. Today, following a meticulous restoration, Il Palagio operates as one of the region's most refined biodynamic wine estates.

### Oenological Approach

Il Palagio's wines are crafted by two of Italy's most esteemed winemakers — Riccardo Cotarella and Paolo Caciorgna — whose expertise bridges the depth of Tuscany's native grape varieties (Sangiovese, Canaiolo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot) with a refined and contemporary oenological philosophy. Il Palagio is created for those who appreciate not only the taste of wine, but the story it tells — its origin, the people behind it, and the landscape that shapes it.

**In 1997**, Sting and Trudie Styler purchased Il Palagio and began extensive restoration work.



### **Style & Craftsmanship**

Bellavista sparkling wines are produced using the Méthode Classique (Traditional Method, as used in Champagne), blending base wines from multiple vintages and aged extensively on lees—often for up to 60 months or more.

### **Reputation & Recognition**

Over the years, Bellavista has maintained a leading role in Italy's premium sparkling wine scene. The estate consistently receives high praise from international wine critics and publications including Wine Spectator, James Suckling, and Gambero Rosso.

## LOUIS MICHEL & FILS

Authority and Minimalism at the Heart of Chablis

Domaine Louis Michel & Fils stands as one of the most respected and established names in the Chablis region. Situated in the northern part of Burgundy, the estate traces its winemaking legacy back to at least 1850, with family records dating as far as the 17th century. Today, the domaine is led by Guillaume Michel, a winemaker devoted to preserving tradition while expressing the character of each terroir with clarity and precision.

### Philosophy

Louis Michel & Fils is renowned for its fundamental commitment to purity: since 1969, the domaine has made a deliberate choice to vinify and age all its wines exclusively in stainless steel tanks. This approach allows each cru to fully express its natural, mineral-driven identity — free from the influence of oak and extraneous aromas.

## Chablis Premier Cru





Champagne Drappier is one of France's most renowned family-owned Champagne houses, founded in 1808 in Urville. Still run by the Drappier family today, it is celebrated worldwide for elegance and authenticity.

Known as the "House of Pinot Noir", Drappier crafts Champagnes with depth, character, and aromatic richness. The range spans classics like Carte d'Or to innovative cuvées such as Brut Nature Sans Soufre, made with minimal sulfur and in a pure, dry style.

Drappier is one of the most respected family-owned Champagne houses, preserving tradition for over 200 years. The house and its cuvées are frequently highlighted at international competitions and by leading wine critics worldwide.

Drappier's Champagnes are regularly awarded Gold Medals at prestigious competitions and consistently receive 90+ scores from critics such as Wine Spectator, Decanter, and Robert Parker.
